Childsplay's Student Activity Guide for *This is Not A Pipe Dream*

Today you saw a production of *This is Not A Pipe Dream* performed by Childsplay. Here are some things to talk about and some activities to do now that you've seen the show!

Tell your family and/or friends about the play!

◇ Tell them about the story and the characters: What happens in the beginning, the middle and the end of the play? How many characters can you remember? Which character was your favorite and why? What were some of the things the characters did? What was your favorite part of the play?

◇ Tell them about the costumes, scenery, props, and music that were used in the production. Draw pictures to help describe the different costumes and scenery.

◇ Tell them about René's dream to become a painter. René's mother tells him to always honor his dreams. What does she mean? What are your dreams? Has anyone ever discouraged you from going after your dreams? Is there someone who encourages you to go after your dreams?

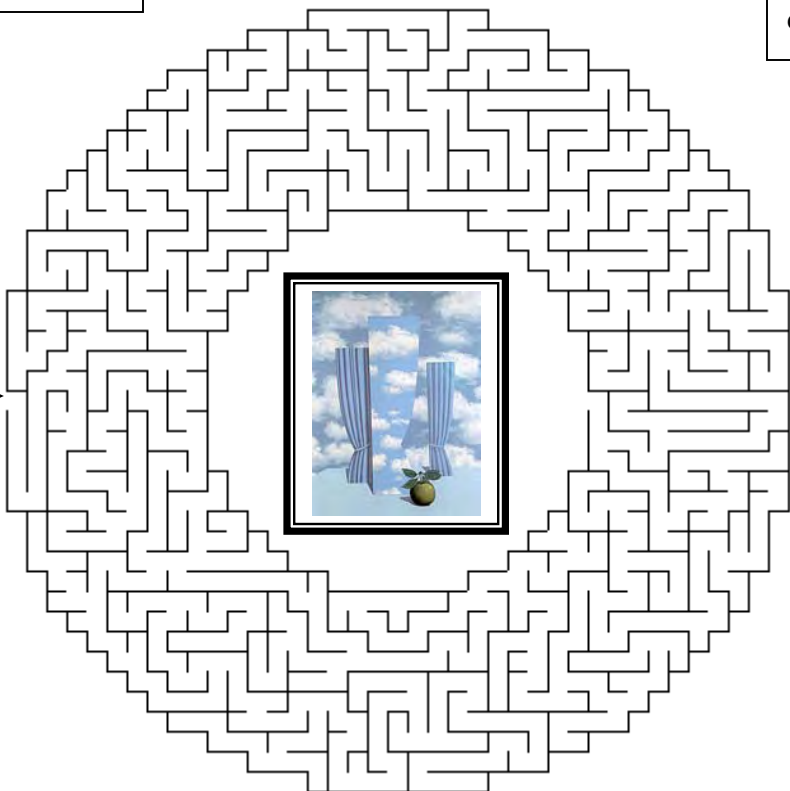
