Tell your family and/or friends about the play you saw. . .

◇ Tell them about the story and the characters. What happens in the beginning, the middle and the end of the play? How many characters can you remember? Which character was your favorite and why? What were some of the things the characters did? What was your favorite part of the play?

◇ Tell them about the costumes, scenery, props, lights, puppets, music, and sound effects from the production. Draw pictures to help describe things you talk about.


◇ Tell them about something new that you learned from the play.

◇ If you could play any of the characters, which one would you choose? Why?

Safety Public Service Announcements:

In the play, Peter's grandfather tells him not to go into the meadow because of the dangers there. What sorts of dangers do your parents and grandparents warn you about? Come up with a short commercial (sixty seconds or less) that teaches about an element of safety. Write your ideas down, rehearse the commercial and then share it with your family, friends or class. If you can, record it with a camcorder and then watch it!

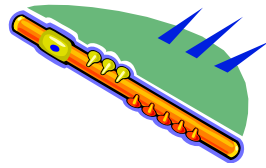

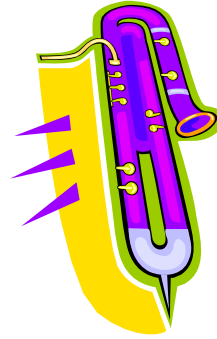

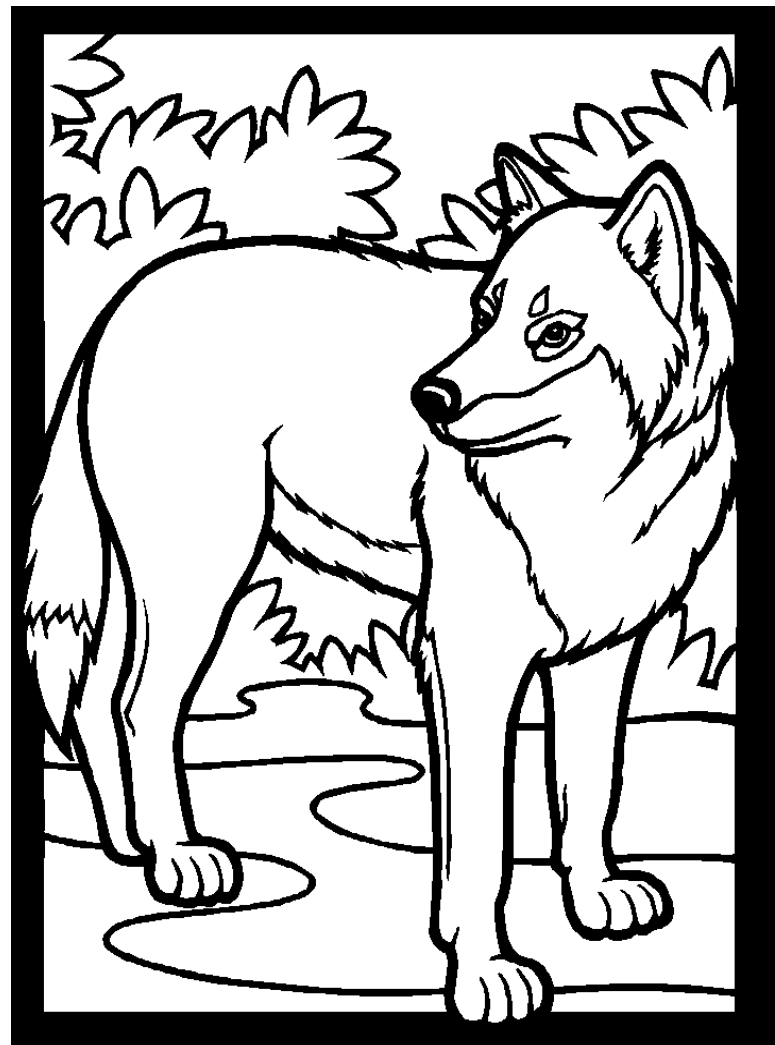
