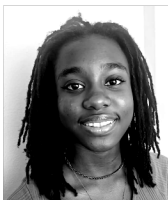

Samantha "Sammy" Capleton (Orderlie 2, Ghost 3, Soul 2): This is Sammy's first production at YETI, and first ever show!

Anastasia Goro (Ora - Cast A) started her YETI journey with The Plot, Like Gravy, Thickers (Allegra Worthington) and Ghost Bike is her second YETI show. She enjoys performing at Marcos de Niza High School in shows such as; Grease (Frenchy), Puffs (Susie Bones), Romeo and Juliet (Nurse), Charlotte's Web (Sheep), and Almost Maine (Hope). She also enjoys makeup design and has been the co-lead of the makeup department for The Wizard of Oz and You Can't Take it With You (both also at her high school).

Miles Whelan (Soul 4, Rider 1): This is Miles's fourth production with Yeti. 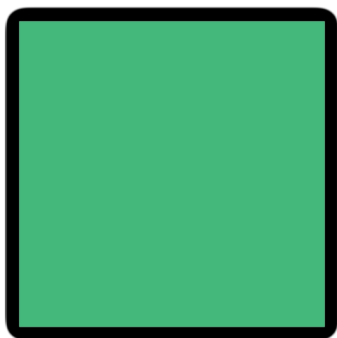
