Childsplay, an internationally acclaimed ensemble-based professional theatre for young audiences located in Tempe, Arizona (Greater Phoenix) seeks a proactive, creative individual to lead our Scenic Department. Childsplay produces 6 productions at the Herberger Theater Center on Stage West, 1 national tour, and 1 to 2 local state tours per year. Contract begins June 20, 2022.

Hours: Full-time non-exempt position

Compensation: \$44,200 per week + benefits, PTO, and training opportunities. Relocation assistance is possible.

Job Summary and Responsibilities:

- The Technical Director (TD) is responsible for the scenic aspects of productions produced by Childsplay at the Herberger Theater Center and for tour.
- Working within the established policies and procedures of the organization, with the assistance of a Master Carpenter and overhires and with oversight by the Production Manager
- Set build for each production per season
- Assist other designers as needed
- Establish and implement a weekly schedule to maintain the technical shop area and theater technical equipment
- Provide general support of the overall production quality of each show
- Assist in general maintenance of the shop
- Provide assistance when needed for technical set-ups on the property for special events
- Attend weekly staff meetings.

Experience:

The ideal candidate will possess:

- At least 1-2 years of experience in design/construction of sets
- Working knowledge of AutoCAD or Vectorworks
- Must have experience in welding and rigging
- Ability to effectively delegate and lead a team that includes the Master Carpenter, and any over hires, as well as crews for load ins and strikes
- Adhere and manage a per production budget
- Ability to recruit, train, and retain over hires
- Strong organizational skills
