



Paint Charge Artist Job Description

Summary of Position:

The Paint Charge Artist will oversee the paint treatments of all scenic elements on all mainstage and touring productions. The Scenic Charge will oversee the scenic artist over hire and other relevant staff/interns in a safe and proper usage of paint tools, techniques, and materials. This position will work nights, weekends, and holidays as needed.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the technical director in order to execute all painting needs
- Work to make sure all painting deadlines are met
- Collaborate with technical director on times for paint notes and touch ups in space
- Create a touch-up paint kit upon opening/departure date
- Adhere to any provided paint elevations from scenic designer
- Attend Production Meetings as needed
- Maintain a clean and safe work area at all times
- Carry out other duties and responsibilities that may be assigned by direct supervisor or management.
- Assist in setting up the paint resources in a new scene shop and help move resources from previous shop to new shop.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Knowledge of theatrical scenic painting and surface treatments
- Ability to read construction drawings and paint elevations
- Thorough knowledge in paint tools and in cleaning, care, and maintenance of all paint tools
- Effective communication and collaborative skills
- Ability to work and collaborate effectively with crews
- Ability to work on multiple projects simultaneously



- Ability to work as an effective team member and maintain a positive attitude in stressful situations
