DIRECTIONS

Scottsdale Museum of Contemporary Art is in downtown Scottsdale at East 2nd Street and Drinkwater Boulevard.

Going west on **Indian School Road** from the 101:


- Turn left (south) onto **Drinkwater Boulevard**
- Turn right (west) onto **East 2nd Street**
- Scottsdale Center for the Performing Arts and SMOCA on the right

From **Scottsdale Road**:

- Going south, turn left (east)/ going north, turn right (west) onto **Indian School Road**
- Turn right (south) onto **Drinkwater Boulevard**
- Turn right (west) onto **East 2nd Street**.
- Scottsdale Center for the Performing Arts and SMOCA on the right

DROP OFF

Your bus or van can drop off on East 2nd Street in the circular driveway outside Scottsdale Center for the Performing Arts (first short arrow off E. 2nd St). Staff will greet you here and direct you to the adjacent bus/van parking (second short arrow).




PARKING

Free public car parking is available in the Center for the Arts Public Parking Garage at 3888 N Wells Fargo Ave off East 2nd St between the Museum and Los Olivos Mexican Restaurant.

Accessible parking is available in the Center for the Arts Public Parking Garage at

3888 N Wells Fargo Ave, and limited accessible spaces are available in the circular driveway outside Scottsdale Center for the Performing Arts.

School Matinee Etiquette

To prepare students and chaperones, please review the following simple guidelines and responsibilities prior to arriving at the theater, especially if this is their first time at a live performance.

- **House managers** will welcome you to the Center. They will help you with any questions you might have and guide you to your seats. Please do not sit on stairs as this is prohibited by the fire marshal.
- Once everyone is seated, **please exit or enter the theater only when absolutely necessary**. This is a courtesy to your fellow students and others in the theater.
- **Feet belong on the floor, not on the seats.**
- **Cameras or recording devices may not be used in the theater.** If students carry a cell phone they must be turned off inside the theater. No texting is allowed. Flash from a camera can be dangerous to a performer moving on the stage.
- Once the performance has started, **please remain quiet**; again this is a courtesy so that everyone in the theater, including the performers, can hear what is happening on stage.
- At the conclusion of the performance, staff and volunteers will usher you and your class back to your bus. You may also eat lunch on the lawn.
